**Fun family learning activities for Easter**

Week commencing: 6.4.20




**All these activities can be repeated several times throughout the week to reinforce the skills.**

**PSED to cover throughout the week**

**Jigsaw- this week’s focus – How am I feeling today? – I am starting to recognise and manage my feelings.**  
 Draw some faces on a piece of paper or look at some picture/photos of faces e.g. happy, sad, angry.

- Ask your child to point to one of the faces.
- How does that face look? E.g. happy, confused
- Ask your child if they have ever felt this way?
- What made them feel that way? E.g. I felt happy because you hugged me. I felt sad because I hurt myself
- Talk about other things that make us feel differently. Feeling nervous on the first day of school, feeling angry when someone takes a toy
- Talk to your child about things they could do when they have strong feelings e.g. If you’re scared tell a grown up. If you’re happy pass on a smile. If you’re angry use your words.



**Phonics activities for Easter.**

- Sing some familiar rhymes/songs
- Make up some rhymes/songs or change ones you already know  
*e.g. Mrs Butcher had a school ee i, ee i, o,  
 and in that school she had some children ee i, eei, o  
 with a chatter chatter here and a chatter chatter there..... (sung to the tune of Old Macdonald)*
- Who can make up the silliest rhyme or song?
- Clap the rhythm of the rhyme/song as you sing
- Enjoy story time, which books will you read this week?
- Talk about what you enjoyed in the story.
- Who was your favourite character and why?
- Where did the story take place? E.g. town, forest? Beach?

**Maths - Shape, space and measure – Repeating pattern.**  
**Create a family rainbow**

Draw/paint/colour a rainbow for your window using a repeating pattern as below. Put your rainbow in your window to keep your local community smiling.



**Activity 2**

**Literacy/ Design/Construction – writing/reading**  
**Den building**

Draw a plan for a den/fort. Think about the different resources you can use from inside and outside the house. When it’s finished, label it using cursive handwriting (windows, walls, roof, door, boxes, sheets). Try and read your labels back to your adult. Next build your den/fort inside your house or in the garden. What activities can you do inside your den?


**(Nursery- talk about the position of where objects are e.g. on top, behind, next to, under, at the side, in front. Talk about comparative size of the resources they are using e.g. bigger/smaller/longer/ shorter/ biggest/smallest/longest/shortest. Ask your child why they have chosen a particular resource, can they begin to give reasons for their choices?)**

Think about the things that are different to your everyday lives usually (e.g. not being at school, creating your own fun adventures in the house, having dinner together every night.)</p> <p>It can be something to keep as a memory of this time, that you can look back on to remember, when we eventually get back into the fast-paced lives we usually lead!</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Activity 2</b></p> <p><b>Maths - Space, shape and measure - measure time in simple ways</b></p> <p>Jumping Bunnies (inside or outside activity)</p> <p>Imagine you are a bunny jumping happily around a meadow in spring. Don't stray too far from your rabbit hole in case a 'fox' comes on the prowl!</p> <p>-Start by choosing a spot where your rabbit hole will be. Use a marker such as a cushion.</p> <p>-Jump around the room/garden from two feet to two feet.</p> <p>-Make sure that you are using all of the space.</p> <p>-When you hear your adult shout 'FOX' jump back to your rabbit hole as quickly as you can. <b>Ask your adult to count/time how long it takes you to get back to your rabbit hole. You could write down the number on a piece of paper. Repeat this activity and see if you can get back to your rabbit hole before your adult reaches the same number. Were you faster or slower? Swap roles with your adult, who is faster, you or your grown up?</b></p> <p>-Now repeat and change the way you travel (bunny hop, skip etc.)</p>

You could make chocolate Easter nests using rice crispies, shredded wheat or cornflakes or maybe a savoury dish e.g. Spaghetti Bolognese, Vegetable chilli. Show your grown up how to cut, chop and grate safely.</p> <p><b>Literacy – Instruction writing</b></p> <p>Nursery – When finished, can you tell your grown up each step you took to get to the end result?</p> <p>Reception – When you have finished, can you write a set of instructions for each step of cooking or baking your dish.</p>	<p>-something that needs sunlight to grow</p> <p>-something red</p> <p><i>(This activity can also be done as indoor scavenger hunt using items found in and around the home)</i></p>

Using the following words- first, next, then, after that, finally.</b></p> <p><b>Reception – write a set of instructions for making your basket using some the following words - first, next, then, after that, finally.</b></p> <p>Make a junk model basket for your Easter treats. You could use an empty cardboard box/ yoghurt pot/folded paper then decorate it how you would like. Talk to your grown up about how you are making it.</p> <p>Questions – What materials have you used? How did you attach the handle?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Activity 2</b></p> <p><b>Maths – Positional language</b></p> <p>Go on an Easter egg hunt around your house/garden. Use positional language (under, behind, in front, next to, inside) to tell your adult where you found the eggs. (Other items can be used- toy cars etc.) Use the basket you have created to collect your items.</p>

Can you write a list or label each one to show where you recorded that particular texture? E.g. cupboard door, tree, hard floor, paving stone</p>
