

GEOGRAPHY

As geographers we will be exploring countries from around the world and which animals are in danger in those countries. We will also describe the basic needs of animals for survival.

SCIENCE

In science we will be learning about food chains and how they affect the circle of life for animals. The children will then spend time studying different habitats and how animals are suited to their environments. We will also be observing changes over time through life cycles.

ART

As artists the children will be creating 'Pop art' using a variety of media. We will focus on developing our use of drawing, printing and sculpture skills to create a variety of representations of animal art.

COMPUTING

We will be learning to understand that information can come from many different sources, including digital and non-digital. We will also organise ideas and information using mind maps. MUSIC

As musicians we will be composing music to match a story. We will experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using instruments of animals.

P.E.

We will be learning to play in team games involving rolling, hitting, running, jumping, catching and kicking skills in combination.

We will also choreograph an animal dance to music, moving in a clear, fluent and expressive manner.

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

The children will create animal homes and habitats to shelter the diversity of animals that we have at school. The children will be using natural resources found in our school grounds to blend in with the natural environments.
