



Malvern Way Infant & Nursery School Pupil Premium Impact Report (academic year) 2015 -16

The level of Pupil premium for 2015-2016 is £1320 per pupil for pupils eligible for free school meals, £302 for children eligible for Early Years Pupil Premium and £300 for children with parents in the armed services. CLA receive £1900.

Impact of funding on Pupil Outcomes

Reception (5 children)

Progress of our PP group is in line with cohort progress in all areas. Progress for this group is greater than progress for the cohort in the areas of Communication & Language (CL), Personal Social and Emotional Education (PSED) and Expressive Art and Design (EAD).

3 out of 5 pupils (60%) achieved a Good Level of Development. Of the 2 who did not achieve, one pupil has an EHCP and is working at levels significantly below their peers.

Year 1 (4 children)

Progress of our PP group is greater than whole cohort for Reading, Writing and Maths. 3 out of 4 pupils are achieving at expected levels (A2+) in all areas. 1 child is currently working toward expected standard.

Year 2 (1 child)

Child in receipt of pupil premium achieved the expected standard in Maths but not in Reading or Writing. Analysis of the progress of this child shows they have made expected progress since entry to Nursery.
