

## SCIENCE and GEOGRAPHY

In Science we will be learning about the features of animals and how they adapt to their environment. We will be exploring different habitats, including local habitats in school and learning about habitats further afield such as the Rainforest and the Polar Regions. We will also group animals according to what they eat within food chains.

As geographers we will be using interactive maps and resources to explore our planet and where some of the Roald Dahl characters have been. We will learn to take responsibility for developing and improving the woodland areas, making sure our school habitats are safe for animals to live. We will also be creating our own maps using physical resources to plot Roald Dahl characters and settings to retell stories.

## ART

We will be learning to draw in the style of Quentin Blake. We will take inspiration from his work to create our own pictures using pencil drawings and water colours.

## MUSIC

As musicians we will be listening to 'Dream Music' from the BFG soundtrack so that we can create our own music using a range of instruments. We will be drawing pictures to interpret the music we hear.

## COMPUTING

We will be learning the importance of internet safety before we go on to search for information about Roald Dahl and his characters. We will be learning to type appropriate questions that will give us the information we need and then we will go on to present our findings. We will also create an advert in an attempt to promote our chocolate bars that we will make in DT.

## DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

We will be designing and making our own chocolate bars using a range of materials and skills. The children will make their chocolate bar based on a consumer survey that they will take in class.

## P.E.

We will be learning to throw and catch with accuracy and use a range of equipment to create our own games. We will learn to take part in competitive sport and work in a variety of different teams. In dance, we will choreograph and perform a movement to match a Roald Dahl story that we have read in our classes.

## R.E.

We will be learning about the significance of signs and symbols in everyday life. At Christmas time we will learn about giving and receiving of gifts as well as visiting 'The Labyrinth' at the local Baptist church.
