SCIENCE

COMPUTING

We will continue to learn the importance of internet safety before we go on to search for information about London. We will be learning to use a controllable device and giving it instructions to guide it around a maze.

HISTORY

As Historians we will be looking at a variety of evidence from the past. We will be thinking about how we know about the past and we will compare it to modern day life.

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

In DT we will be learning how to bake bread. We will be measuring out our ingredients and following recipes. We will also be building model houses out of wood and burning them to re-enact the Great Fire of London. We will investigate why the houses in London were no longer built out of wood from 1666 onwards.

P.E.

In PE we will be developing our orienteering skills which will involve using maps and guiding ourselves around our school environment. We will be using iPads to locate objects and take pictures of them to map out our routes. We will also take part high intensity PE lessons to ensure we are raising our heart rates for sustained amounts of time.

ART

As artists we will be using a range of media to create pictures of famous landmarks as well as looking at work inspired by London and artists from the area.
